ACCESS AND TRANSPORTATION

Ketchikan International Airport is a 90-minute charter jet or commercial flight from Seattle. Transportation between the port town of Ketchikan and the Club includes a scenic, 45-minute floatplane flight over Alaska's famed Inside Passage and the Tongass National Forest. The Club's ground crew in Ketchikan facilitates guest transfers, including luggage and fish box handling. Our reservations crew is available to assist with hotel stays and additional land, air, or sea arrangements in Ketchikan.

THREE - NIGHT SAMPLE ITINERARY

DAY 1

5:00 - 5:30 AM / Check-in with Steamboat Staff in the Cape Fox Lobby, transfer to seaplane dock for 45-minute flight to Craig. Continue by boat from Craig to Noyes Island, welcome to Steamboat Bay Fishing Club!

7:00 - 9:00 AM / Eat breakfast and then head out for a full day of fishing, whale watching, sightseeing - you can choose your schedule! Lunch will be served on the boat unless you prefer to head back to the resort.

4:00 PM / Boats return, your fish will be processed and vacuum-packed.

6:00 - 8:00 PM / Dinner. Guests can kick back with a specialty cocktail, local brews, or relax on the deck overlooking the bay.
